

Please...

- Park cars in front parking lot
- Use restrooms at Envr. Edu Center during open hours
- Stay on trails and walk with a friend, not alone
- Picnic near the Envr. Edu Center (no cooking)
- Fish only on the West and South shores of Lake Kirsty (see map)
- Follow NYS Fishing Regulations
- Remember to walk and talk quietly to better enjoy the wildlife
- Take only pictures and memories; leave only footprints

Please Do NOT...

- Collect, release, or feed wildlife
- Disturb wildlife or visitors
- Pick or eat flowers, plants, or fruits
- Bring dogs or any other animals
- Swim, boat, jog, or bike (bicycle rack available)
- Park at Envr. Edu Center without authorization, a handicapped permit or plates. Envr. Edu Center parking lot closes at 4 p.m.
- Walk on ice on any body of water
- Use drones, kites, motorized toys, sleds, toboggans, inner tubes, ATVs, or snowmobiles
- Hunt, trap, build fires, or bring firearms
- Bring drugs or alcohol anywhere on the Preserve

Tifft Nature Preserve is...

...a 264 acre wildlife refuge at the Outer Harbor in South Buffalo providing year-round educational programming, outdoor recreation, and environmental conservation. It is operated by the Buffalo Museum of Science and features five miles of beautiful trails, diverse habitats, and Herb & Jane Darling Environmental Education Center.
